HOSTAS COLLECT RAINWATER ON THEIR BROAD, WAXY, LANCEOLATE OR OVATE LEAVES AND CHANNEL IT DOWN TO THEIR ROOTS BY THEIR LEAF STEMS. IN HEAVY RAINFALL SOME OF THE WATER IS LOST DUE TO IT FALLING OFF THE LEAF TIPS, THIS LOST WATER COULD POTENTIALLY BE HARVESTED AS PART OF A BIGGER SYSTEM INCORPORATING OTHER 'BIG-LEAVED' PLANTS.
